Noted in the Annandale Observer of 30th July 1897

"Golden wedding - Canadian papers report: Golden Wedding of Mr & Mrs Patterson of River Road, Dover, Ontario on the 25th June last. - Couple married 50 years ago at Tinwald, Dumfriesshire and subsequently resided at Barrasgate, Cummertrees. 17 Years ago they emigrated to Canada - they have 10 children and 41 grandchildren"

This ties in precisely with the report I sent:

Applegarth marriage proclamations. [marriages were proclaimed in the Church of each party] [813A/2 fr 133] dated 30th May 1847 James Paterson in Fourmerkland and Jane Irving in Tinwald. Paid 2/6. married elsewhere.

Marriage in the Bride's parish was the norm, it would have been Tinwald sometime in June 1847.

It seems that the family from Scotland were all living together in 1881 in Harwich Twp. There are two Douglas children.

In 1891 they have all moved to Dover Twp and live either in the same house or certainly next door to each other. The films did not include the schedule which shows details of the houses.

By 1891 John Patterson married a nice Scottish lassie, Fannie, and they have started a family. Did they meet on the boat?

In 1897 we know that James and Jane celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in Dover Twp.

In 1901 most of them are living on part of lot 3 concession 3 Harwich Twp. James and Jane have their daughter Mary and her son James living with them.

When Jane died in 1902 the death was registered in Harwich Twp.

When James died in 1905 the death was registered in Chatham.

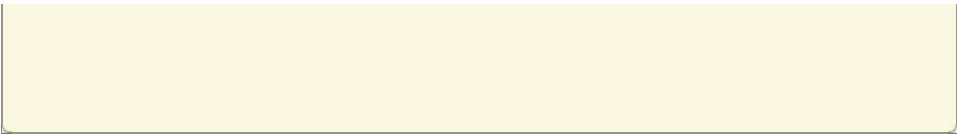
